Parking Around School

Dear parent/carer,

As you will be aware, there have been a number of improvements made to Baring Street in front of our school. These include upgraded road surfacing, new markings and a crossing. All of these measures have been taken to ensure the safety of our children.

However, sadly, we still have had a number of issues with parking around school, particularly at the front of the site. A small minority of parents/carers are continuing to park in restricted areas or drive at excessive speeds. **If this continues, it will only be a matter of time before a child is seriously hurt or even killed.**

There are approximately 600m of free parking space, which could accommodate up to 100 vehicles around the front of the school. Compared to many other school sites, this provides above adequate provision within the locations highlighted, rather than all cars gathering in Baring Street.

For the safety of all of our children, we ask you to park in the highlighted areas on the map.

Traffic regulation orders exist at both school entrances onto Baring Street and the junction area of Fort Street and Baring Street is covered by an 8-9.30am and 3-4pm no waiting and no loading order to prevent parking over crossing points and junction areas. These measures can and will be enforced by Parking Enforcement Officers from South Tyneside council when they are present. If parents/carers are found to be parked illegally, they will be issued with a fine.

For the safety of our children, please park and drive responsibly.
