


Literacy

natural objects to create a picture! This might be in the garden or at the beach! Pop your photo's on seesaw!

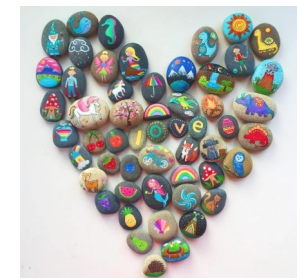


Reception Autumn 1 Topic Take Away
